ADULT GUIDANCE (Ages 16 and under)

Any child volunteer *16 and under* will also need an adult to attend the training in order to help directly with the animals at the shelter and supervise the child volunteer until the child is capable of doing the work unassisted. A minimum of three times is required. Every child is different. Most of the younger children will need more guidance, and the older ones closer to the minimum. The volunteer's adult helper and the director will discuss and agree that the child is ready for independent volunteer status.
